INTRODUCTION

The communication campaign, led by ISMU with the participation of all partners involved in the project, is intent on foster exchanges between newly arrived migrants and hosting societies. This document shows Unconventional Maps, that are a new orientation for newly arrived migrants and citizens. In order to foster the integration between hosting society and newly arrived, maps have been implemented in the neighborhoods of four European cities: Lisbon (Bairro das Galinheiras), Nicosia, Milan (Central Station-Martesana canal) and Perugia. These maps based on streets, spaces, squares of the territory and on people's feeling related to that, contains unconventional information such as: libraries, sports offer, language courses, cultural places etc.

These maps are also meant to be a resource for citizens who wish to discover hidden spots of their city. What makes these maps unique, however, is that the "unconventional" places featured are the result of a co-design process conducted with the project beneficiaries, including diaspora members (Community Agents) as well as children and university students, who decided to share their experience, knowledge, stories, emotions and memories associated to the city.

The creation of the unconventional map followed 3 phases:

- 1. Phase 1 MAP DESIGN through the work of focus groups (composed by community agents, representative of diaspora associations and local associations involved in the project)
- 2. Phase 2 The treasure hunt, once created, the map has been fed by the people who live the territory (citizens, voluntary associations, diaspora associations and local associations). The idea behind this treasure hunt is to discover the value and richness of the territory and its heritage which is the real "treasure" of the hunt
- 3. Phase 3 upload and publish the map. The 4 unconventional maps created, (one per territory), have been translated into 2 foreign languages according with the most represented arrival nationalities, then printed as a folding A3 map and distributed to newly arrived migrants thanks to the contribution of diaspora associations.


